Please consider purchasing the following to fill the buckets.

(The amount needed per bucket and other details are in parentheses).

Donations may also be made to meet this need. Write “Cleaning Buckets” in memo line of check or on an envelope.

- Liquid laundry detergent (1 - 50-oz. or two 25-oz. bottles)
- Liquid household cleaner (1 - 12-16 oz. only cleaner that mixes with water, no spray)
- Dish soap (1- 16-28 oz. bottle, any brand)
- Clothespins (50)
- Clothesline (1 -100-ft. or 2 - 50-ft. lines, Cotton or plastic)
- Sponges (7 - No cellulose sponges)
- Heavy-duty trash bags (24 - 33-45 gal.)
- Cleaning wipes (Handi-wipes or reusable, No terry cloth)
- Air freshener (1)
- Insect-repellant spray (1)
- Kitchen dishwashing gloves (2 pairs)
- Work gloves (1 Pair- All Cotton or leather)
- Scouring pads (5 - No stainless steel, nothing with soap built in)
- Scrub brush (1-Plastic or wood handle)
- Dust masks (5)
